	TO BE COMPLETED BY PARTNER UNIVERSITIES
Nomination procedure for Universities	Students have to be nominated by their universities through email. The body in charge of this procedure is the UFPC's International Relations and Mobility Office (internacional@upfcanarias.es).

Although early nominations are strongly recommended, the following stipulated calendar applies:

• For 1st semester or full academic year: by May 1st

• For 2nd semester: by October 1st

## TO BE COMPLETED BY NOMINATED STUDENTS

Application procedure for nominated students

Students nominated by their home institutions and accepted by the UFPC will receive an email with the steps to follow and the documents to be forwarded.

Attention: Every non-European student is responsible to apply for a visa or any other procedure established by the Spanish Authorities. In this case, we strongly recommend getting in touch with the Spanish Consulate or Embassy in your home / residence country, prior arrival, in order to get updated information regarding entry and residency requirements.

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PRACTICAL INFORMATION	
Accommodation	UFPC does not offer accommodation through student

residences or similar facilities. We strongly recommend our incoming students to plan accommodation in advance.

Prices may vary depending on the area and the characteristics of the accommodation, but the usual prices may be included among the following ranges:

Santa María de Guía:

o Room : 250€-350€o Studio : 450€-550€

Las Palmas de Gran Canaria:

o Room: 300€-400€o Studio: 550€-700€

We are currently collaborating with property rental places, called <u>Spotahome</u> and <u>Uniplaces</u> focused on student accommodation. You will get some discounts by using the code UFPC25 (Spotahome) or UP25UFPC (Uniplaces).

In addition to that, we strongly encourage you to review <a href="Idealista">Idealista</a> and <a href="Fotocasa">Fotocasa</a>, which are the two main websites posting accommodation offers. <a href="Erasmusu">Erasmusu</a> will also have some offer mainly focused on exchange students.

As in many other cities in Europe, we have been realizing very lately about scams when it comes to accommodation appearing around here, specially while looking for short term accommodation. We strongly encourage to watch out "to good to believe" deals, landlords requiring payments in advance, even before arriving to Spain, or any other red flag. It does not necessarily have to be a scam, but we encourage to pay special attention to these details while looking for accommodation.

## **Transportation**

There are two major bus companies in Gran Canaria: <u>Guaguas</u> (yellow buses; limited to the municipality of Las Palmas de Gran Canaria), and <u>Global</u> (blue buses; connecting the rest of the island). Mobile APPs are also available.

UFPC facilities are located in Santa María de Guía, in the north of the island of Gran Canaria. The university is easily accessed by public transportation lines from GLOBAL lines 100, 103 and 105 stopping at *Guía* or *Instituto de Guía* or line 336 stopping at the entrance of the university.

Parking facilities are also available on site.

	Please, do bear in mind you will have to comply with some local and state administrative procedures before getting the documents requested by the local transportation authority in order to issue your transportation card (Wawa Joven; under 28 yo); (Residente Canario; above 28 yo).  In order to get your transportation card, the local transportation authority will request from you to get a NIE (Identification Number for Foreigners), as well as being registered in the municipality you will be living (Empadronamiento).  We strongly encourage you to pick up an appointment before arrival, in order to apply for these two procedures as soon as you arrive in Gran Canaria or even expedite the process.
Visa / Registration-NIE Procedures	<ul> <li>EU and EEE Citizens shall get a NIE (Identification number for Foreigners) once arrived in Spain. This personal number will be requested for every single administrative procedure in Spain. Once assigned, this number remains the same lifetime.</li> <li>Citizens originally from a country outside from the EU and EEE might have to check entry requirements. In any case, we strongly recommend to apply for a visa, if applicable, in your country of origin (even if your nationality allows you to enter the country and apply for the permit directly in Spain:         <ul> <li>TIE (identification card) shall be requested upon arrival. This process is mandatory if staying 6 months or more, and optional if staying under 6 months.</li> <li>If the residence permit is requested directly in Spain, you must comply with this procedure within 60 days upon arrival</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
